Therefore, it is important that the entire house church use this tool as a way to invoke positive dialogue, prayer, and growth. Debriefing helps us to be self-aware and keeps us on track. Are all four directions of God’s love occurring in our MKF: Down, Up, In, Out?

1. Every member of our Missional Kingdom Family understands and wholeheartedly agrees with the core values, vision, and strategy of our local church. _____
2. Each person understands and is committed to the expectations and commitments involved in being a member of our Missional Kingdom Family.
3. Every member of our Missional Kingdom Family participates in all aspects of our life together. _____
4. Every member of our MKF is in a DNA Group. _____
5. Every member of our MKF feels like that have been adopted as a “son” by their heavenly Father, and a wanted and loved “son” in this spiritual family. _____
6. Each member of our MKF gives and receives the delight, affection, and affirmation from Father through the other members of the family. _____
7. We connect relationally in other situations and settings during the week outside our family/house church gatherings. _____
8. We regularly enjoy each other over meals, at play, informally and “organically”. _____
9. Our MKF relationships and atmosphere/culture is positive, joyful, merciful, and enjoyable. _____
10. Our MKF helps people feel free to be themselves, while at the same time always encouraging growth into Christ’s likeness. _____
11. When our MKF members cannot attend, they make sure to communicate with the family/house church leaders.
12. The members of our MKF like and enjoy one another as friends both inside and outside our gatherings.
13. Our leaders function as healthy spiritual parents who are used by Father to communicate and emit His love, delight, affection, truth, wisdom, and power. They declare and demonstrate Father’s heart to us consistently. _____
14. Our assistant leaders are being prepared in every way to accept responsibility for leading another spiritual family/house church.
15. Our MKF has a clear and compelling mission to reach others for Christ in our community. _____
16. We glorify, love, and minister to our heavenly Father through Christ by the Holy Spirit as a lifestyle
17. Whenever we come together we all practice biblical praise and worship such as corporately thanking and praising God, songs, hymns, spiritual songs (singing new songs inspired by the Holy Spirit). _____
18. Whenever we come together, we all exuberantly and demonstratively express our appreciation and love to God (clapping, dancing, hands raised, bowing, kneeling, shouting, etc)
19. There is a freedom in our MKF to bring glory and pleasure to God versus the fear of man, pride, self-consciousness, religious duty, and inhibitions. _____
20. We use the Word of God (like the Psalms) as our guide to help us minister to the Lord together. _____

30. We often have a couple of our adult family members train our children in the Word of God and kingdom lifestyle in a way that is age relevant to them. _____

We love and minister to one another:

31. Each person is viewed as both a disciple of Christ and as an emerging or actual leader. Therefore, each person regularly sets goals using the 5 C’s (Christ, Community, Character, Calling, Competence) using the 4 D’s (Dynamics of Transformation: spiritual, experiential, relational, instruction). _____
32. We have a culture and practice of regularly praying for each other, even doing inner healing and deliverance when necessary.
33. Our MKF “fellowships in the light” meaning that we practice sharing our inner conversations, confess our sin, and live transparently before one another and God. _____
34. Each member of our MKF is in a DNA Group for accountability, discipleship, and outreach. _____
35. Our MKF culture and atmosphere is positive, loving, safe (nonjudgmental), merciful, peaceful, open, joyful, even fun a lot of the time.
36. Our MKF freely and easily shares what is going on in their lives, relationships, hearts, work, finances, etc. _____
37. Our MKF are discovering their callings and spiritual gifts and are encouraged to practice their gifts in the safety of their spiritual family. _____
38. We celebrate the Lord’s Supper (communion) on a regular basis.
